CDM is seeking a professional and experienced part-time or full-time Contratados.org Project Manager to join our dynamic, binational, multilingual team! The Project Manager will principally oversee Contratados.org development, partnerships, and operations as we prepare to launch the platform's exciting next phase. In particular, the Project Manager will work with technology vendors to develop a portability pathway prototype and website interactive features, effectively incorporating feedback from workers. He or she will work in partnership with the Executive Director, forging private sector relationships around the portability pathway, to develop a criteria by which CDM will list certified jobs and identify potential partners to expand and disseminate the portability pathway. The Project Manager will also work in coordination with members of CDM's communications and outreach teams.

Position Responsibilities:

- Manage the day-to-day needs of Contratados.org efforts, including tracking project budgets, facilitating meetings/events, developing communications, reviewing security, and serving as a liaison to outside groups.
- Hold focus groups with migrant worker leaders to design and test technology interventions to respond to workers' needs.
