With the recent NAFTA renegotiations, CDM is launching a three-year project to empower workers and civil society to shape the implementation of NAFTA 2.0, hold governments accountable to their commitments on labor protections and gender equity, and use the labor chapter as a tool to improve working conditions. Key Responsibilities

- Monitor and analyze labor protections for migrant workers under the recently renegotiated free trade agreement between Mexico, the United States and Canada (T-MEC)
- Train organizations and authorities with respect to the new agreement
- Organize and lead meetings with civil society organizations and other stakeholders
- Present cases using the mechanism contemplated in the treaty
- Lead outreach and workshops to workers
- Track relevant developments in Mexican politics and legislation regarding NAFTA renegotiations
- File cases to test NAFTA 2.0's enforcement mechanism
- Coordinate CDM staff efforts, monitor project budget and draft reports

Desired Qualifications

- Fluency in English and Spanish is required
- Organizing experience
- Strong cultural competence and the ability to engage effectively with various individuals in a multicultural, diverse organization
- Familiarity with a range of computing applications
